Datalogic Mobile will expand its product range by distributing DLoG X-series industrial computers as a part of their own R Series portfolio of robust computers based on Windows CE for mobile applications.

The technological basis of the OEM partnership relates to the DLoG X-series terminals. These touch screen terminals are designed up with IP67 class protection against dust and waterproofing in an aluminum housing with a fanless design. They are available in 7-inch (X7), 10.4-inch (X10) and 12.1-inch (X12) models.

Datalogic Mobile will distribute the high-performance ARM architecture units under their own R Series brand name with a Windows-CE operating system. The R Series brand name stands for robust, vehicle mountable terminals that are especially suited for demanding applications in extreme environments with operating temperatures from -30 to +50°C (-22 to 122°F).
