with DLoG X-series industrial computers Olching and Bologna, 22nd September 2008 – Datalogic Mobile and DLoG GmbH announce the agreement of a global OEM contract on Sep 1st, 2008. Accordingly, Datalogic Mobile will expand in the future market by distributing DLoG X-series industrial computers as a part of their own R Series product portfolio – robust computers based on Windows CE for mobile applications.

R Series stands for robust, vehicle mountable terminals that are especially suited for demanding applications in extreme environments with operating temperatures from -30 to +50°C (-22 to 122 °F).
